Kurzweil 3000

Kurzweil 3000 is text-to-voice software that reads text out loud in a variety of voices. It is useful for:

- People with vision impairments.
- People with learning disabilities.
- People for whom English is a 2nd or additional language.

Headphones and a scanner to use with Kurzweil 3000 can be checked out at the circulation desk.

To begin using Kurzweil 3000:

- 1. Turn on the computer.
- 2. Start the software by double clicking on the Kurzweil icon



3. Plug in headphones (or earbuds).

To upload an electronic text:

- 1. Plug in a USB drive containing the document. Note: Kurzweil works with Word documents and most PDF files.
- 2. Inside Kurzweil, click on the open icon 🗐 and navigate to the document.

To upload a printed text:

- 1. Connect the scanner to the computer.
- 2. Place the printed text face down on the scanner.
- 3. Click on the Scan icon 3.

To read the text:

- 1. Put on the headphones or (earbuds).
- 2. Click on the Read icon .
